Other educational activities

My discipline and subjects

In Trinity College Dublin, I teach **Medical Gerontology** with the overall mission to help face the current and future challenges of ageing by supporting education on ageing, geriatrics and gerontology, both at **undergraduate** and **postgraduate** levels. The Discipline also has outreach educational initiatives to enhance societal awareness and attitudes towards ageing.

As Faculty member of Trinity's <u>Global Brain Health Institute</u> (GBHI) I provide mentorship to the Atlantic Fellows for Equity in Brain Health, developing and delivering innovative training in brain health, leadership and dementia prevention to a very diverse group of postgraduates from various countries and professions, including medicine, science, business, law, journalism, social science, and the arts.

Course development

- In Trinity, I have developed and launched the <u>Postgraduate Certificate (P.G.Cert) in Advanced</u> <u>Ageing and Frailty Studies</u>, which is a 30 ECTS course directed towards a wide range of healthcare professionals, including medicine, nursing and allied health disciplines, who wish to improve their knowledge and inform their clinical practice in the area of frailty.
- I have developed and launched the <u>Stand-alone module on Assessment and Management of</u> <u>Frailty in Ageing Adults</u> (5 ECTS), which runs in partnership with <u>EIT Ageing Health PhD School</u> and attracts internal Trinity M.D. and Ph.D. students taking the module as part of their structured research degrees.
- At the undergraduate level, I have contributed to the development and delivery of the first <u>Trinity Elective Programme on Ageing: "How to live long and prosper – A lifespan approach"</u>. This undergraduate module has a unique interdisciplinary focus and offers Medical Gerontology teaching to all undergraduates in Trinity.
- In Cambridge, UK, I founded and directed the 2017 and 2018 editions of "The Cambridge Essential Skills Course on Caring for Older Adults in the Acute Hospital (COACH)" (Twitter handle: <u>#COACH_CUH</u>).
