We invite you to participate in the 9th Central European Congress on Osteoporosis and Osteoarthritis together with the 21st PTOA Congress, which will be held online on September 28-30, 2023. The Congress is organized under the auspices of the International Osteoporosis Foundation. Participation in the Congress is free of charge. Participants receive educational points. We anticipate the participation of about 4,000 participants. The number of places is limited; the order of applications is decisive.

The scientific program of the Congress includes the latest data on issues such as: osteoporosis diagnosis and fracture risk assessment, the place of bone-forming and anti-resorptive drugs in the treatment of osteoporosis, osteoporosis in metabolic diseases and in the elderly, problems in long-term treatment, prevention of cancer metastases, fractures in diabetes, fractures osteoporosis, sarcopenia and falls, analgesic therapies and others.

Outstanding speakers will present 48 lectures, including 38 in English. Afternoon sessions will be only in English. Prof. Jean-Yves Reginster will present the Opening Lecture:

"Bone forming agents: are they the solution to close the gap in the treatment of osteoporosis?"
