The DET is a member of the Executive Board and is responsible for coordinating the EuGMS activities related to Education and Training in close collaboration with the SIG on Education and Training: https://www.eugms.org/research-cooperation/special-interest-groups/education-training.html.

As a member of the Executive Board, the DET shares with all other Executive Board members the responsibility of Director of EuGMS in accordance with our Bylaws (https://www.eugms.org/fileadmin/eugms-data/legal and statutory/EuGMS AISBL - By-Laws - Final - ENG - EY Law.pdf)

Previous experience in Education and Training Programs is a preferred condition.

Term of office: 4 years

General Responsibilities of the DET:

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- Establishing and granting close relations and active collaboration with members of the Academic Board and General Assembly.
- Work with UEMS on the new version of the Undergraduate Curriculum (next stage a Delphi process via UEMS).
- Work with the SIG Co-leaders and the UEMS towards progressing on the European exam.
- Facilitating implementation of the decisions of the Executive Board on Education and Training among the SIG.
- Work with SIG Co-leaders to set agenda of other work e.g. progression on interdisciplinary collaboration.

Practical activities include:

- Attending the meetings of the Executive Board; 1 per month generally online, and 4 in person meetings: Spring Meeting (March), June Meeting, Meeting at the Annual Congress (September/October) and Winter Meeting (December).
- Attending monthly online meetings with the Co-leaders of the SIG on Education and Training, currently Andreas Stuck and Mike Vassallo.
- Attend the larger meetings of the SIG (3 x year- mainly online meetings)
- Managing information flows between the Executive Board and the SIG on Education and Training, EAMA, UEMS.
