

## **RESEARCH DIRECTOR (RD)**

The RD is a member of the Executive Board and is responsible for the research policies and activities.

The RD is also an observer member of the Academic Board.

As a member of the Executive Board, the RD shares with all other Executive board members the responsibility of Director of EuGMS in accordance with our Bylaws (<a href="https://www.eugms.org/fileadmin/eugms-data/legal">https://www.eugms.org/fileadmin/eugms-data/legal</a> and statutory/EuGMS AISBL - By-Laws - Final - ENG - EY Law.pdf)

Term of office: 4 years (January 2024 to December 2027)

## General Responsibilities of the RD:

- Proposing to the Executive Board a global Research strategy.
- Implementing the decisions of the Executive Board for the research activities.
- Supervising the evolution of the involvement of the EuGMS in the different research projects.
- Collaborating with the Academic Societies that have MoU with the EuGMS for the initiation/participation in research programs.
- Collaborating with the leaders of the EuGMS Special Interest Groups (<a href="https://www.eugms.org/research-cooperation/special-interest-groups.html">https://www.eugms.org/research-cooperation/special-interest-groups.html</a>) in order to coordinate possible research initiatives.
- Collaborating with the Academic Director for the presentation of the results of the research work in the Annual EuGMS Congress

## Practical activities include:

- Attending the meetings of the Executive Board; 1 per month generally online, and 1 to 3 in person meetings: Spring Meeting (March), June Meeting, Meeting at the Annual Congress (September/October) and Winter Meeting (December).
- Supervising the work of the EuGMS Scientific Liaisons Officer.
- Liaising with Partners Scientific Societies.
- Attending the meetings of the General Assembly; 2 in-person meetings per year: Spring Meeting (March), Meeting at the Annual Congress (September/October).
- Attending the meetings of the Academic Board 1 per month generally online, and 2 in person meetings: Spring Meeting (March), Meeting at the Annual Congress (September/October).
- Co-Organising with the Academic Director an annual meeting of all SIG leaders (during the Congress).
- Reporting directly to Executive Board and the General Assembly (according to meeting's agenda) about the research activities.
