

Criteria for evaluating the Nutrition Research Grant

- 1. Compliance** with grant rules
- 2. Rigor of the proposed research.** The research proposal will be evaluated based on its scientific quality, including the clarity of the research question, the appropriateness of the methodology, and the potential for significant findings
- 3. Relevance and potential contribution** of the project to geriatric medicine and older adults.
- 4. Viability and feasibility:** The feasibility of the research project will be assessed, considering factors such as available resources, timeline, and the capacity of the research team in which the applicant will be embedded to successfully carry out the proposed study
- 5. Potential impact:** The potential impact of the research project on the field of study, including its potential to contribute to knowledge, inform practice, or influence policy, will be considered
